






The purpose of this letter is to present the final results of the September 2017 National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) audit of California conducted by the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Division, CJIS Audit Unit. Audit results are based on the assessment of requirements set forth in applicable laws, regulations, rules, policies, and procedures. For this audit, assessments were conducted of the California Department of Justice.

The NICS audit resulted in no findings requiring corrective action and a response is not required to finalize the audit.
